

## How to Host a Facebook Fundraiser

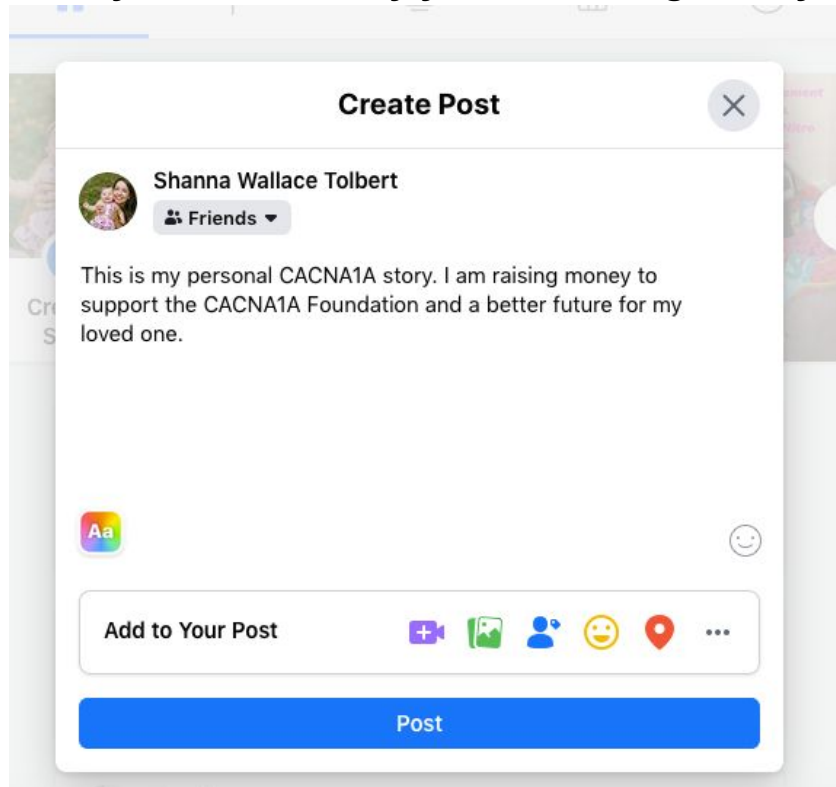

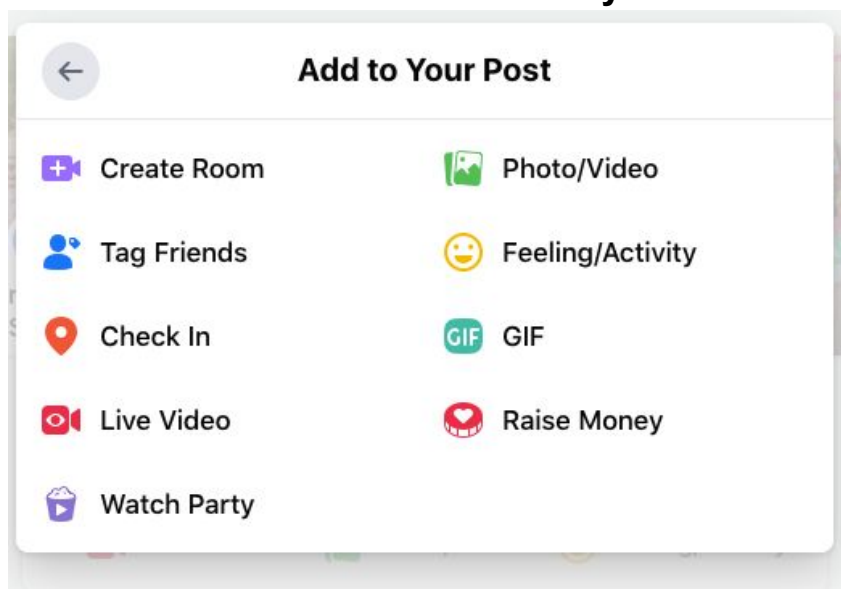
#### Step 1 Start a Status Update

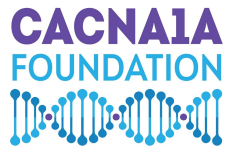

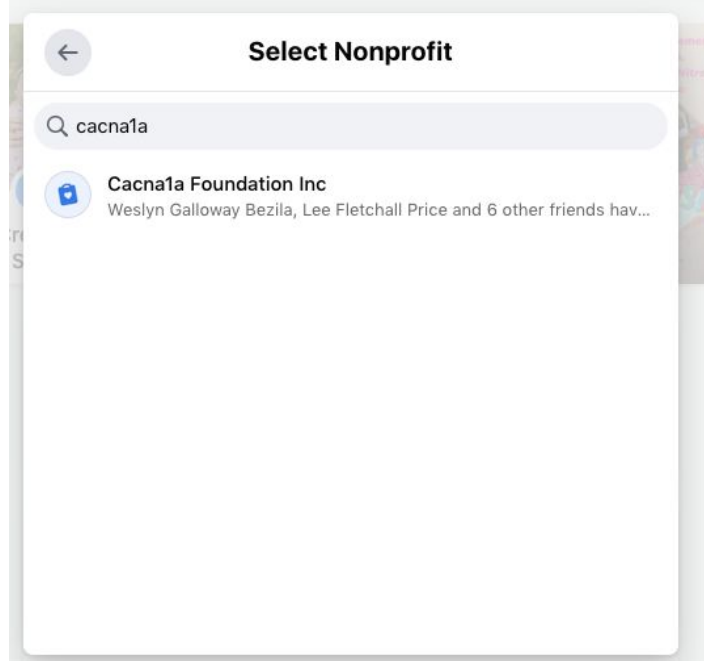

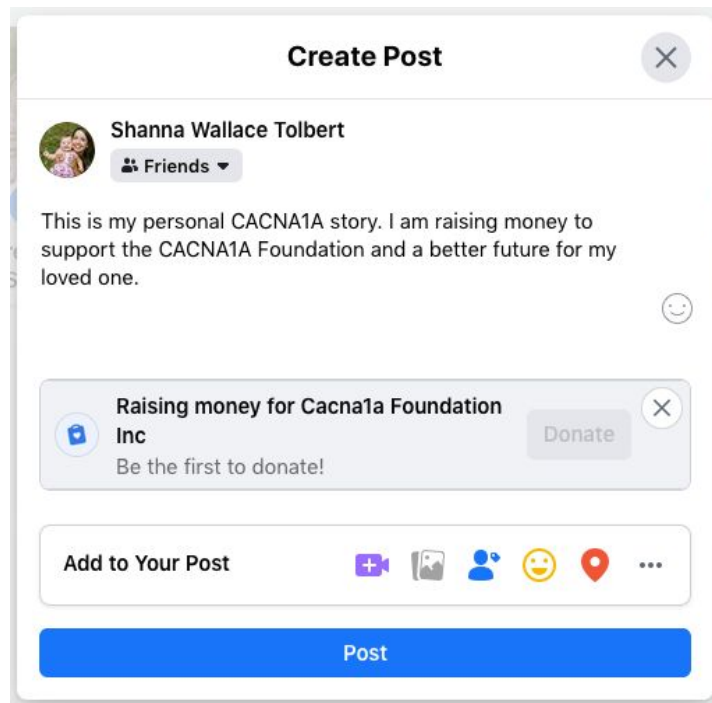


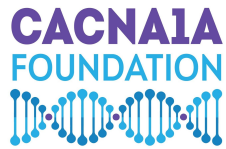


## Step 4 Search & select the CACNA1A Foundation, Inc
